Poker offers the variation of Lowball known as Deuce to Seven Lowball i.e. Single Draw, also sometimes referred to as Lowball. Blinds: Lowball is played by means of enforced bets known as blinds, with the player sitting to the left of the dealer button posting a little blind, and the player to their left posting the large blind. The little blind is typically equivalent to half the size of the large blind.

Lowball is also frequently played with an bet, which is a little enforced gamble posted by every player in addition to the blinds. The Deal: every player is dealt five cards face down. There is then a round of gambling, where you contain the alternative to either call, increase or fold. Players still left in the hand following the initial round of gambling at this time have the chance to draw.
